# WHAT A GAS!



Green projects include:

**BIOGAS** – power from poo! This gives fuel for cooking, lighting and heating – and provides a fertiliser for plants and crops as well.

**CLEAN WATER SUPPLIES** – providing wells, repairing and laying pipes, collecting rainwater. Making sure people have clean water to drink is really important – especially for babies and young people.

**PLANTING TREES** – gives a new and renewable source of fuel (wood) and, most importantly, helps stop soil erosion.

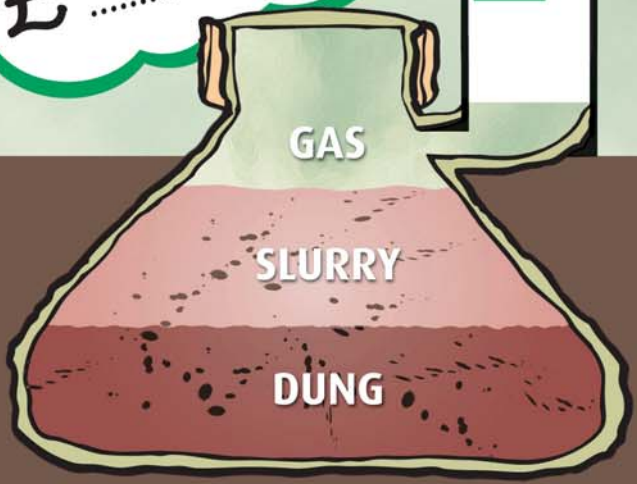
**SOLAR ENERGY PANELS** – these reduce carbon emissions and give people living in rural, far-off places electricity for the first time. They use the electricity for lighting, heating and cooking.
